NOTES

This map is for use in administering the National Flood Insurance Program. It does not necessarily identify all areas subject to flooding, particularly drainage sources of small size, or all planimetric features outside Special Flood Hazard Areas. The community map repository should be consulted for updated flood hazard information prior to use of this map for proper planning or construction purposes.

Coastal base flood elevations apply only landward of 0.0 NGVD, and effects of wave action; these elevations may also differ significantly from those developed by the National Weather Service for hurricane evacuation purposes.

Areas of special flood hazard (100-year flood) include Zones A, AE, AV, V, and VE.

Certain areas not in Special Flood Hazard Areas may be protected by control structures.

Boundaries of the floodways were computed at cross sections and in between cross sections. The floodways were based on hydraulic computations with regard to requirements of the Federal Emergency Management Agency.

Floodway widths in some areas may be too narrow to show to scale. Widths are provided in the Flood Insurance Study Report.
