Fees

Fees are payable at the time of delivery.

Fees must be paid at the Dover-Foxcroft Town Office Monday Through Friday

Fees paid at the Solid Waste Facility on Saturdays.

The Town will establish two days per year “free days” when fees will not apply for residential waste disposal with the exception of paint. On these days, residential disposal of tires at no fee will be limited to 4 tires less than 20”, stuffed furniture (2 piece limit), TV’s/Computer Monitors [CRTs] (limit 2) per person/per permit. “Free days” will be the first Saturday in May and the second Saturday in October unless otherwise posted.

Prohibited

Mattresses and box springs are not accepted at the Dover-Foxcroft Solid Waste Facility unless disassembled and separated by wood, metal, etc.

Carpet must be cut into 4’ x 4’ squares.

Loads greater than 6 yards not accepted at the Dover-Foxcroft Solid Waste Facility.

For larger demolition projects-- If you do not wish to separate sheet rock, shingles, insulation, glass, etc., the following haulers have 15 to 40 yard open top containers for rent:

Material will be hauled to a licensed disposal facility. Cost will vary according to waste type, weight, and mileage to licensed disposal facility.

Definitions

Demolition Debris – Debris resulting from construction remodeling, repair, and demolition of structures.

Municipal Solid Waste (MSW)- Solid waste emanating from households and normal commercial sources. MSW does not include liquid waste of any kind.

Commercial Waste- Solid waste generated by stores, offices, restaurants, warehouses, and other non-manufacturing, non-processing activities. Commercial waste includes waste generated by an individual or business during the course of commercial activities or any waste transported to the facility by any individual or business as part of a commercial activity. Commercial waste also includes any waste generated by any institutional, governmental, or nonprofit entity.
