**Resolution recognizing the Climate Action Advisory Committee (CAAC) as a town advisory committee on the issue of Climate Change and Climate Resiliency**

**Whereas:**

The Dover-Foxcroft Select Board wishes to take a more formal approach to address the issue of Climate Change and Climate Resiliency to better prepare for and mitigate the future effects of warming temperatures:

**Be it Resolved as follows:**

That the Select Board recognizes the Climate Action Advisory Committee as a Town Committee;

That the Committee will gather information relevant to Climate Change (including Broadband) and ways the Town may become more resilient to warming temperatures and reduce its dependency on fossil fuels;

That the Committee will advise the Select Board on the issue of Climate Change and Climate Resiliency based on the information it has available;


That the Committee will inform the Select Board of opportunities it becomes aware of such as grants, programs to address issues related to Climate Change and Climate Resiliency, and participation in regional efforts;


That the Committee will report to the Select Board on or about quarterly, or more frequently if necessary to carry out its objectives;






