III. Site Plan Review – Storage and Parking as requested by Bruce Tibbetts on Lincoln Street, Map 36 Lots 142 & 143

Abutters were present to speak. A couple of issues were brought up. One was that a right of way to the house at the back of the property felt that product display was too close to the road which was blocking the view of traffic making a hazard to cars pulling out of the right of way. Tibbetts assured them that he could pull the product back to address that concern in 10 minutes. Most of the other concerns were the congestion already at the site and the shortage of parking. Tibbetts was unsure of how to address some of the issues until he was able to see how it all worked together for the busy season. After much discussion, the board agreed to allow the Tibbetts to put their ideas in motion but to come back at the September meeting with a plan for parking which would separate parking and pedestrians. The Board would then review the parking, buffering and a mutual agreement on the right of way. Tibbetts was cautioned that the use of the lot across the street for warehousing product could still be turned down.

- 3. Marijuana Maas updated the board on how the advisor for the land use committee board wished to proceed on this issue. Decisions will be made after town meeting vote.
