ARTICLE 3: To see if the Town authorizes the Dover-Foxcroft Select Board to enter into an agreement with the Atlantic Salmon Federation (ASF) and The Nature Conservancy (TNC) and others as may be beneficial for removal of the Mayo Mill Dam through the use of funds secured by ASF and TNC not through local taxes (initial estimated construction cost \$6,308,500), to initiate a process to develop a plan for a restored riverfront including enhancements to support economic and recreational opportunities for the downtown as well as opportunities for historic preservation, and to secure non local taxpayer funding to make riverfront improvements consistent with the plan (estimated cost \$6,000,000), all on the terms and conditions to be negotiated and approved by the Select Board acting in the best interest of the Town.
